EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- At completion of the course, the trainees would have acquired skills to develop and implement a research project in the area of TB and TB/HIV in Ghana
- In addition, the trainees will produce outlines on appropriate TB and TB/HIV research proposal that could be developed into a thesis, dissertation or clinical project.
